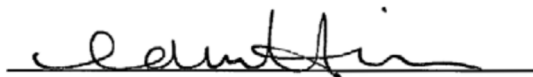
FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 24

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 24 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, August 6, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2400, in the Sabine Conference Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Receive comments from the public.
3. District security matters, including approve Interlocal Agreement for Additional Law Enforcement Services between Fort Bend County, Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 23, and the District.
4. Development in the District.
5. Maintenance of District drainage facilities, including proposals for work.
6. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
7. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
8. Discuss 2026 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate.
9. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, and message language on water bills.
10. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.

- c. deeds, easements, plats and consents to encroachment;
- d. requests for service or utility commitment letters;
- e. update on bond application no. 9;
- f. installation of street lights on Lake Olympia Parkway and Chimney Rock Road; and
- g. park improvements.
- 13. Consider amendment to Agreement between the District and LJA Engineering, Inc. for Professional Services.
- 14. Park and recreational facilities matters, including:
