

## NOTICE OF MEETING


### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 24

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 24 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, January 5, 2023, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **24<sup>th</sup> Floor, Sabine Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Receive comments from the public.
3. District security matters.
4. Report on development in the District.
5. Maintenance of District drainage facilities.
6. Annual report regarding Post-Issuance Compliance Policy.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
  - a. payment of the bills and review of investments; and
  - b. accept annual disclosure statements for Investment Officer and bookkeeper.
8. Authorize submission of adopted budget, itemized estimate of maintenance expenses, and invoice to Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 168 pursuant to the Cost Sharing Agreement for Maintenance of Detention Pond B7.
9. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
10. Garbage and recycling matters, including update on textile recycling services.
11. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, and message language on water bills.
12. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
13. Public Utility Commission rules regarding extreme weather emergencies, including issuance of one-time notice to customers and adopt Amended Rate Order.
14. Engineering and park construction matters, including:
  - a. design, plan approval, advertisement for bids and contract award, and approval of pay estimates and change orders, and materials and field testing, including:
    - i. Olympia Fields Phase 1 Detention and Drainage;
    - ii. Olympia Fields, Section 1;
    - iii. District facilities to serve the annexation tracts, including:
      - aa. construction of new wastewater treatment plant; and
      - bb. water line extension to serve the annexation tract;
    - iv. hardscape and landscape to serve Winfield Lakes North, Section 6;

- v. sidewalk improvements Phase 1, including tree donations;
  - vi. hardscape and landscape to serve Winfield Lakes North, Section 7;
  - b. renewal of Wastewater Treatment Plant permit;
  - c. update on amending the District's Park Plan;
  - d. proposal for water reuse study;
  - e. deeds, easements, plats and consents to encroachment; and
  - f. requests for service or utility commitment letters.
- 15. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Plan, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.
  - 16. District website and communication matters and related proposals.
  - 17. Reports from Directors and District consultants on District operations.
